
DEATH OF MR. JOHN WATSON.

Successful Business Man Passes Away After a Long Illness.

The funeral will take place this afternoon from his late residence, 127 Isabella street, of Mr. John Watson of the firm of Lalley, Watson & Bond, wholesale clothing manufacturers, who died on Thursday after a lingering illness.
