

THE J. D. IVEY ESTATE.

The Stock Sold to Nicholas Garland—
A Trustee Appointed—McPherson &
Co., Hamilton, Assign.

Mr. R. Millichamp has been appointed trustee for the estate of J. D. Ivey & Co., the wholesale milliners on Wellington street, who recently suspended payment. The stock, it is understood, has been purchased by Mr. Nicholas Garland, at a figure understood to be in the neighborhood of \$20,000. Mr. Millichamp will carry on the business for the creditors until some settlement be reached. Mr. Ivey left for the old country to-day to meet his creditors.

John McPherson & Co., boot and shoe manufacturers, Hamilton, have assigned to C. S. Scott, and a meeting of the creditors will be held at the Rossin House on the 13th. The firm recently suspended and an offer of 10 cents on the dollar was made for the assets of the estate. A committee of three was appointed to look into the value of these assets, and it was judged better in the interests of the creditors that the firm should assign.

At a meeting of the creditors of D. Ferguson, boot and shoe merchant, St. Thomas, a statement was presented showing liabilities of \$9,475 and assets of \$9,626. Mr. Ferguson made an offer of compromise which was not accepted, and the estate was ordered to be wound up. The stock, valued at \$8,501, will be sold by auction on the 16th.

Mrs. Whatmough of 481 Church street, has assigned to Mr. E. R. C. Clarkson. She is the widow of the late C. T. Whatmough, who conducted a coal oil and lamp business, and became responsible for some of her husband's debts. The estate is not a large one.
