PARKDALE.

COUNCIL MEETING.

The Council met last night. Present—Councilors Frankish, Walker and Coles. In the absence of the Reeve, Mr. Frankish was called to the chair. The following communications were received: From Mono Iron Works re Water-Works; From the County Clerk, stating that the amount of county tax was \$416 25; and from Wm. Morrison re hose reel. The contract for the grading of several streets was let to A. B. Axworthy. The prayer of a petition from Wm. Hamilton and others for a sidewalk on the south side of Queen-street, from Cowan-avenue to Dowling-avenue was granted. The by-law fixing the salaries of the assessor and collector at \$100 respectively was read a third time and passed. The by-law relating to pounds was amended, locating the pound in rear of the **Parkdale Hotel**, and providing that cattle may be led or driven to the pound. It was agreed to purchase a hose reel at a cost of \$150, and to prepare contracts for the several works about to be commenced. The following bills were passed:—Night watchman, \$25 07; road overseer, \$24; help cutting thistles, \$4 25; S. Hobbs, \$5 75; Gas Company, \$1 93; Mrs. McBeth, sundries, \$3 75; G. B. Gordon, arbitration fees, \$110; Godson & West, drainage contractors, \$339; F. Crowhurst, sidewalks, \$200; Wm. Everleigh, grading, \$23 05; W. Godfrey, kerbing, \$16 15; clerk, six months' salary, \$100; rent, three months, \$162 50.

The Council then adjourned till Friday night, when a special meeting will be held.
