## **Soft Spot on Tracks Causes Train Derailment**

**Ottawa, July 19.**—A soft spot on the tracks, due to the recent heavy rains, was responsible for the derailing of a special eastbound Canadian Northern train at Fitzroy on the Pembroke subdivision on Sunday evening. The engine, caboose and two special cars left the tracks when the accident occurred about 6.35, and after ploughing up the rights-of-way for some distance the train was brought to a standstill, without any of the coaches being overturned.
