**WELL-KNOWN BARRISTER DEAD.**

**Mr. Harry E. Caston of Toronto Died at  
Niagara Falls.**

Mr. Harry E. Caston, a well-known barrister of this city, died yesterday at Niagara Falls after a visit to California in search of health. For thirty years he was a resident of Toronto, coming from Putney, England. Deceased was 61 years old and unmarried. He was a Liberal in politics, a member of St. Alban's Cathedral, and a Past Master of Ashlar Masonic Lodge. Captain J. A. Caston, Toronto, is a brother, and Mrs. Homer Dixon a sister of deceased. The funeral will take place on Monday at 3 p.m. to St. James' Cemetery, from the home of deceased's brother, 102 Springhurst avenue.
