Clad only in her nightgown, yesterday afternoon Catharine Pitzer, 10, who was in an apartment above the Jewish Liberal Club, 699 Spadina Avenue, ill in bed, crawled through a third-story window, lowered herself to a small gable roof and then dropped twenty feet to the lawn.
