Protecting Quail and Deer.

An order-in-Council has been passed prohibiting the killing or capture of quail in Ontario until November 1, 1905. The hunting and killing of deer on the Bruce peninsula, except on Cove Island, has also been prohibited for a period of three years. These restrictions were found necessary in order to preserve the game from extinction.
