

MRS. J. O. LODGE FUNERAL TODAY

**Aided Red Cross Until
Illness of Month Ago**

WAS IN 97TH YEAR

Funeral services will be held this afternoon at the chapel of Fred Matthews Company, Spadina Avenue, for Mrs. Elizabeth Lodge, who died Wednesday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. G. E. Patterson, 65 Huntley Street. She was in her ninety-seventh year and was the widow of John Otway Lodge. Services will be conducted by Dr. H. J. Cody, president of the University of Toronto, and for many years a personal friend of Mrs. Lodge.

Despite her advanced age, Mrs. Lodge continued active, crocheting and knitting for the Red Cross until taken ill a month ago.

Born near Woodstock, where she spent her early married life, she had been a resident of Toronto for many years. She was a member of St. Paul's Anglican Church, Bloor Street East. During recent years she had spent much of her time with her daughter in Wellesley Hill.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Patterson of Toronto, Mrs. Clarence Hubel of San Jose, Cal., and Mrs. Nelson Joyce of Delapetto, Ill., and two sons, William Lodge of Los Angeles, Cal., and J. O. Lodge of Saskatoon. Interment will take place in Mount Pleasant Cemetery.
